### **Equis Commissioned 148.1 MW of Solar and Wind Projects in 2014**

Singapore, 27 March, 2017 – From October 2013 through December 2014, Equis, Asia's largest independent renewable energy IPP, commissioned 12 solar and wind projects with a total generation capacity of 148.1 MW.

Beginning in October 2013, in nine months Equis commissioned 10 solar projects in Thailand with a total generation capacity of 91.7 MW. Then in August 2014, Equis commissioned a 54 MW wind project in Andhra Pradesh in India, and in September, its first solar project in Oita Prefecture in Japan.

David Russell, Equis Funds Group CEO, said, "In pursuit of our goal of becoming Asia's largest independent renewable energy IPP, Equis saw an opportunity this year to expand into new markets.
